Mission

Kaun AI - Building the World's Trusted Operating System for Medical Artificial Intelligence (AI)

We envision a future where medical AI is safe, inclusive, and globally accessible - driven by ethical standards, clinical relevance, and international collaboration.

The Challenge

Artificial intelligence has the potential to reshape healthcare - revolutionizing diagnostics, personalizing treatment, and accelerating biomedical discovery.

Despite this enormous promise, medical AI still faces key challenges:

- Fragmented research and siloed development
- Limited clinical validation and real-world testing
- Ethical uncertainties, including data privacy and algorithmic bias
- Low trust from healthcare professionals

Its benefits rarely reach underserved populations. A globally coordinated, transparent, and ethically grounded infrastructure is urgently needed.

Our Solution

Kaun AI is a Berlin-based non-profit pioneering the world's first ethically governed, globally trusted operating system for medical AI.

We combine:

- Agile innovation
- Strong ethical oversight
- Validation hubs in Cairo, Berlin, and Dubai
- A diverse international network of clinicians, AI engineers, and strategic experts

Our goal is simple yet ambitious: to make medical AI trustworthy, inclusive, and effective across borders.

What Already Exists

- Whitepaper outlining our global vision, impact pathways, and strategic roadmap
- Three active pilot projects in Mansoura, Egypt:
 1. MedEd Prototype - AI-assisted training tool for junior doctors
 2. LLM Evaluation in Bladder Cancer - Clinical performance of ChatGPT, Claude & others
 3. AI Model for Adrenal Masses - CT texture analysis for surgical decision-making-Academic partnership with the Medical University of Vienna - GPT-based tool for competency mapping

- Core team of clinicians, AI developers, and strategists across five countries

Next Milestones

- Formal registration of Kaun AI gGmbH (underway)
- Seed funding for 12-18 months of operations
- Development of a transparent financial and partnership framework
- Recruitment of pilot partners and academic collaborators

- The deployment and testing of our MedEd and diagnostic prototypes
- The expansion into international pilot centers with local integration
- The development of our open-source validation toolkit
